

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
March 12, 2015**

The Board of Alderman of the Village of Grosse Tete held their regular meeting at the Town Hall in Grosse Tete March 12, 2015 at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Alderman Kyle Booksh led the Prayer. Alderman Marcus Smith led the pledge of allegiance. Mayor Chauffe called roll and the meeting began.

Present: Mayor Michael Chauffe, Alderwoman Jeanie David, Alderman Kyle Booksh, Alderman Marcus Hill, Public Works Supervisor Phillip Faveroth, Chief Tommy Dardenne, Clerk Pam George, and Fire Chief Michael Hughes

George Francise – Splash Pad: Mr. Francise will provide a quote on two different splash pads that will be presented at the April Regular Meeting of the Board of Alderman.

Minutes: Alderman Kyle Booksh made a motion to dispense with the reading and approve the minutes from the February 12, 2015 regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill. The motion passed 3- 0.

Finances: Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to approve the financial statements of February 28, 2015 as presented. This motion was seconded by Alderman Kyle Booksh and passed 3- 0.

Mayor’s Report:

Sidewalk Project – A Plan in Hand Meeting will be held the week of March 16th, 2015.

Employee Pay Raises – Mayor Chauffe Proposed a 3% pay raise for all maintenance employees and Clerical employee with the exception of the Clerk, Maintenance Supervisor, and Chief of Police. He proposed a \$1.00 per hour raise for the Maintenance Supervisor and the Clerk. He proposed a \$100.00 per month increase in salary for the Chief of Police.

A motion was made by Alderman Marcus Hill and seconded by Alderwoman Jeanie David to accept the recommendation of Mayor Chauffe. This motion passed 3-0.

Mayor Chauffe introduced Ordinance Number 1 of 2015 – Amendment to Chapter 2, Section 2-48 “Section 2.12 Salaries of Officials”. Alderman Kyle Booksh made a motion to set a public hearing to be held on April 9, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. to discuss Ordinance Number 1 of 2015. The motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 3-0.

Entergy Collections – As of April 1, 2015 the citizens of the Village of Grosse Tete and surrounding areas will be able to pay their Entergy Bills at the Town Hall in the Village of Grosse Tete.

Police Department: No Report given.

Fire Department: No report given.
